Request for Proposal

Site Specific Solar facility interconnected to TVA in Lawrence, Alabama.

Introduction:

This announcement constitutes a Request for Proposal (RFP) notice soliciting proposals from qualified solar energy providers to design, engineer, build, operate, and maintain a photovoltaic (PV) power generation facility at a specific site designated by TVA. This RFP does not constitute a commitment, implied or otherwise, that TVA will take action in this matter. TVA will not be responsible for any costs incurred in furnishing TVA responsive information.

TVA is interested in understanding the current availabilities, flexibilities, and preferences of market participants interested in developing a PV generation facility within the Lawrence County Solar footprint (Site). TVA has developed the Site and is now considering the transfer of this Site and procured assets for the Site via a real property easement/lease, and transfer documents for PV panels, and GPU transformer to a selected third party. The third party will construct, operate, and maintain the Site in conformance with the easement/lease and fulfill the obligations of a power purchase agreement (PPA) with TVA.

General Background:

- TVA is a corporate agency of the United States that provides electricity for business
 customers and local power companies, serving more than 10 million people in parts
 of seven southeastern states. TVA receives no taxpayer funding, deriving its
 revenues from sales of electricity. In addition to operating and investing its revenues
 in its electric system, TVA provides flood control, navigation, and land management
 for the Tennessee River system and assists local power companies and state and
 local governments with economic development and job creation.
- TVA's renewable energy programs reflect TVA's ongoing commitment to a
 diversified energy mix that best serves the power needs of businesses and residents
 of the Tennessee Valley in a clean, efficient, and cost-effective manner.

Qualifications and Assumptions:

- All proposals shall offer a PPA for the sale of all energy, capacity, and environmental attributes from a facility located on the Site.
- Nameplate capacity: 193 MW
- Commercial operation date (COD) no later than June 30, 2027
- Interested parties should register on the Power Advocate platform no later than August 16, 2024 to attend the pre-bid conference call on August 19, 2024.
- A non-disclosure agreement (NDA) is required to attend the bidder conference call in September and to review transfer documents and land easement/lease terms.

Submissions:

TVA will utilize PowerAdvocate, a web-based platform to organize all RFP documents and communicate with correspondents. The intended date of initial document release is August 16th 2024. Respondents shall view the RFP package, message TVA, and submit their proposals and RFP related communications through PowerAdvocate.
